Contest Rules & Guidelines

Alamo Area Scavenger Hunt

The Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) will manage the 2020 Alamo Area Bike There Scavenger Hunt contest between 12:00:01 AM CT on September 1, 2020 to 11:59:00 PM CT on November 30, 2020. The contest winner will be announced after the contest period is complete. Two winners will be selected at random to receive a prize.

To be eligible to win the grand prizes, users must visit three destinations from the 2020 Alamo Area Bike There Scavenger Hunt list and email walkandroll@alamoareampo.org three (3) photos of the themselves and their bicycle at Bike There Scavenger Hunt locations. Participants must also be registered members of the [Alamo Commutes platform](#).

All submissions must be entered by 11:59:59 PM CT on Wednesday, November 30, 2020. Alamo Commutes, a program of the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) will fulfill the 2020 Alamo Area Bike There Scavenger Hunt contest prizes.

Social Media Contest Overview

The Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) will manage and fulfill the 2020 Bike There Social Media Contests each week from 12:00:01 AM CT on September 1, 2020 to 11:59:59 PM CT on November 30, 2020. The monthly contest winners will be announced on a monthly basis during this contest period. Each month, one winner will be selected to receive one prize donated by a local business.

To be eligible to win the weekly prize, users must post on Facebook, Instagram, OR Twitter at any time during the contest period. Entrants must use the hashtag #BikeThereAlamoArea and by tagging @AlamoAreaMPO to be eligible.

The monthly winner will be announced via social media postings on Facebook and Instagram. The contest period ends on November 30, 2020 at 11:59:59 PM CT.

Contest Rules and Regulations

1. Entrants must live or work within Bexar, Comal, Guadalupe, or Kendall Counties.
2. Entrants must be 18 years or older to participate.
3. No purchase necessary.

4. Entrants of the Scavenger Hunt contest must be registered members of the [Alamo Commutes platform](#) by the time the contest period ends on November 30, 2020 at 11:59:59 PM CT.
5. Up to two (2) prizes will be awarded for the 2020 Alamo Area Bike There Scavenger Hunt contest. At least one (1) prize will be awarded for each month of the social media contest.
6. To enter, users must follow the criteria outlined above to be eligible.
7. Social media posts must be public to be eligible.
